Barchok commissions Sh 60million Mogogosiek Water project



Governor Dr Hillary Barchok, Tuesday officially commissioned the rehabilitated Mogogosiek-Kapletundo-Kaplong water pipeline project to the relief of t

hundreds of residents who have suffered for a long time following the destruction of the pipeline works during the upgrading of roads to bitumen standards in the

area.

The section of the pipeline reinstated covers three wards: Mogogosiek in Konoin and Kapletundo and Chemagel wards in Sotik.

"Soon we will expand the connectivity to several households in the region to boost supply and access to clean water by households in this region." Dr Barchok said

Itare water supply whose intake works are situated in Mogogosiek ward serves both Bomet and Kericho Counties with a total production capacity of 9,000 cubic metres of clean water daily. 70% of the water produced is supplied locally within Bomet and the remaining 30% to Kericho.

Barchok commissions Sebetet ECDE centre

County. Speaking during the visit, the Governor acknowledged the role played by formative learning as building strong foundation for

The Governor also added that his administration is improving accessibility and mobility in all areas through improved road infrastructure.

Dr Barchok, his deputy Hon Shadrack Rotich and members of the Executive and Assembly also held an interactive session with the area residents in Chebirbelek and Kapletundo centres.
