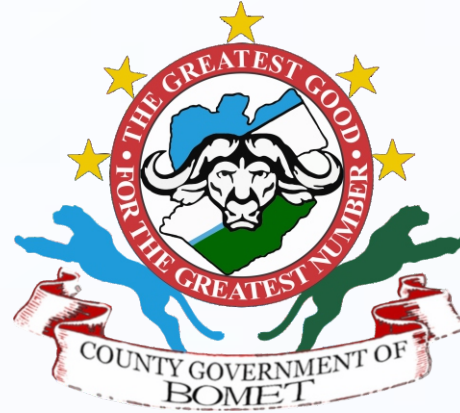

May the Almighty God rest his soul in Eternal Peace!

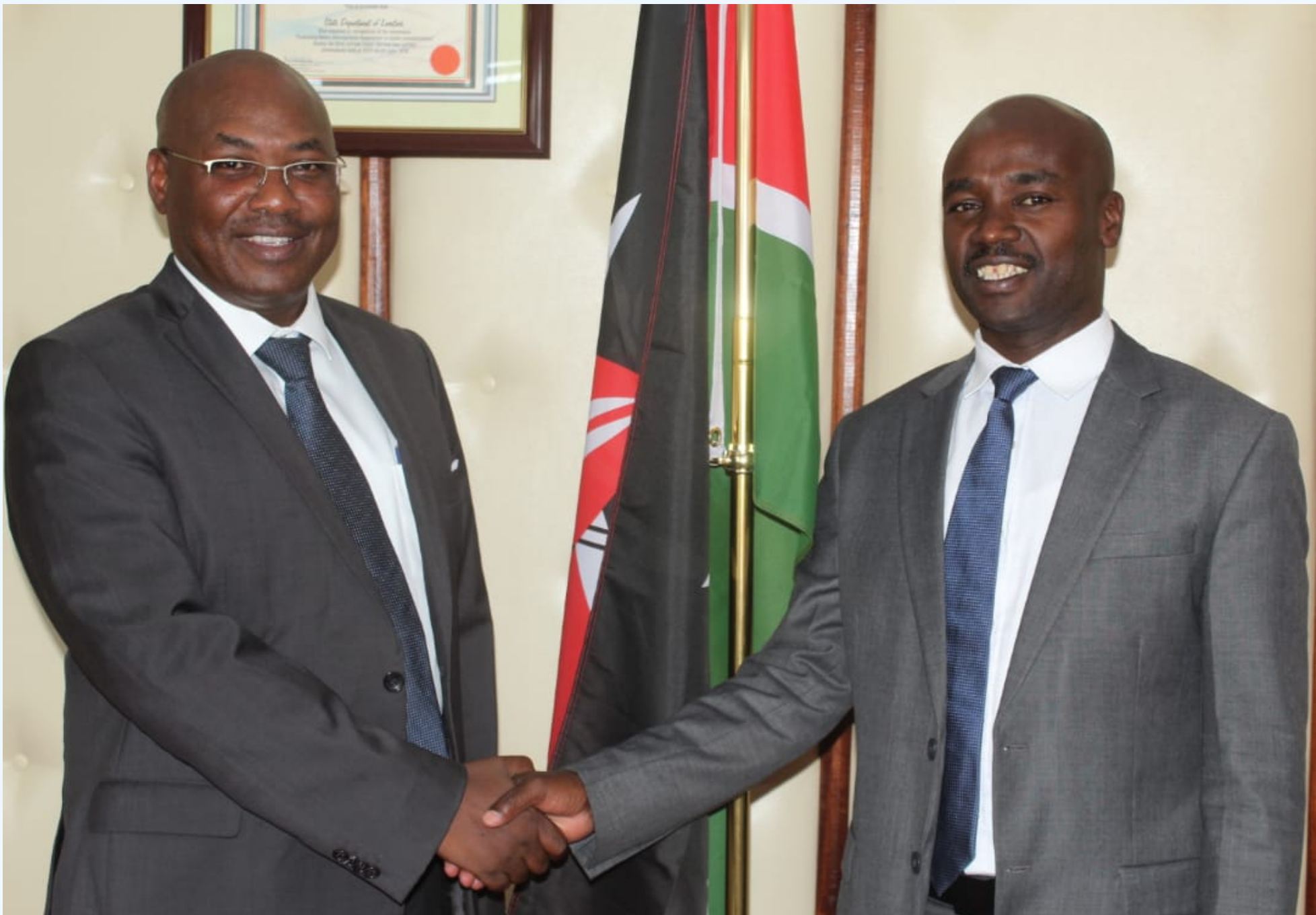

Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock: 26 milk cooling plant for Bomet

Bomet County is set to receive 26 milk cooling machines, through the ministry of agriculture and livestock, Principal Secretary Harry Kimutai said in a talk with Governor Hillary Barchok in Nairobi on Wednesday, February 5th 2020.

Last year, the county government has

received 14 milk cooling plants from the ministry and seven more through Smallholder Dairy Commercialization Program (SDCP).

The county government has already installed 21 milk cooling plants to help farmers bulk and chill their milk through various cooperatives across the county with whom they receive

revolving funds to operate. Bomet produces at least 200,000 litres of milk daily.

Among the cooperative funded include Kapkures, Chepkalwal, Kipsonoi, Balek, Chedda, Ndaraweta and Mulot dairies.
