VACANCIES FOR MULOT, NDANAI, AND MOGOGOSIEK TOWN COMMITTEE MEMBERS- TWO (2) POSTS PER TOWN

The Office of the Governor through the selection panel for recruitment of committee Members of the above-named towns wishes to invite qualified 'persons from the **two (2)** bodies below to nominate a person(s) to fill the vacant positions. Pursuant to the provisions of section 14 of the Urban Areas and Cities Act, 2011, and, the Urban Areas and Cities Amendment Act 2019

The two members of the committee specified under subsection (31) (c) and (d), shall be nominated by:

- a) Cluster representing registered associations of the informal sector in the town
- b) Cluster representing the business community in the town

The nominating organizations/body is required to produce —

- a) signed minutes as evidence of a democratic process of nomination;
- b) evidence of compliance with statutory obligations; and
- c) vetting form to establish that the nominee has complied with the prescribed criteria for appointment as a member of the town committee

Requirements for appointment

- a) Must be a Kenyan Citizen;
- b) holds at least a diploma from an institution recognized in Kenya; Having a degree is an added advantage;
- c) demonstrate capacity to offer Leadership;
- d) has a distinguished career in a medium-level management position in either the private or public sector;
- e) holds at least three years of post-qualification professional experience;
- f) satisfies the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya;

- g) is ordinarily resident or has a permanent dwelling in the town for at least the immediate past five years.

A person shall not be appointed as a member of the Board if that person —

- a) is an undischarged bankrupt;
- b) has been removed from office and has not been cleared for contravening the Constitution or any other law; (380 No. 3 of Urban Areas and Cities (Amendment) 2019)
- c) is not a citizen of Kenya; or
- d) has in the conduct of his or her affairs not met any statutory obligations.
- e) holds a public office either in the national government or the County Government.

The members of the committee shall hold office for a term of five years, on a part-time basis.

The Functions of the committee are as stipulated in Section 31 (1) of the Urban Areas and Cities Act (Amendment) 2019.

REMUNERATION

Town Committee Members will be paid allowances and benefits as APPROVED and determined by the Salaries and Remuneration Commission (SRC)

All written nominations should be submitted in a sealed envelope and addressed to the undersigned on or before **14 September 2023**
