### COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF BOMET SCHOLARSHIPS 2026

The County Government of Bomet is offering **Full Tuition Support Scholarships** for three years to eligible **Senior School Students** in public schools whose **County of origin is Bomet** and **Newly Admitted Trainees** in any of the 33 **Vocational Training Centres** within Bomet County.

The Department of Education, Youth, Sports and Vocational Training invites applications for the year 2026 from eligible applicants Admitted to Public Senior Schools, Special Schools and Vocational Training Centres within Bomet County.

#### **Eligibility**

1. Be 2025 KJSEA Candidates only who attained 50 points and above **from a DAY PUBLIC Junior school**
2. For PWD 2025 KJSEA candidates, they should have attained MINIMUM of 35 points and should be having a valid National Council for People with Disability Membership Card or any other suitable equivalent proof.
3. First year trainee who is a resident of Bomet County and is **newly admitted** in any of the 33 Vocational Training Centres within Bomet County.
4. Be a resident of Bomet County by birth.
5. Demonstrate a need for financial assistance: not able to attend senior school or VTC for reasons arising from loss of one or both parents; parents who are unable to educate their children because they are physically or mentally disabled, living with HIV/AIDS or other chronic debilitating illness; families that have been displaced due to natural disasters such as floods, drought, famine, forced eviction or civil conflict; families that have no evidence of accumulated assets and children who have a past history of school absenteeism due to lack of tuition fees.

All eligible candidates are advised to fill the application form, attach copies of their 2025 KJSEA result slips, relevant recommendation letters and copy of the senior school/ Vocational Training Centre **admission letter (Mandatory)**.



## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Application forms are separately (VTC and Senior School) obtainable from the Department of Education, Youth, Sports and Vocational Training and all ward administrators' offices and in photocopying shops within the wards. The application forms can also be downloaded from the County Government of Bomet official website: <http://www.bomet.go.ke/home/>
2. Have the form ***duly filled*** and appropriately signed and stamped by all the relevant authorities, parents and guardians.
3. Sign the form and **attach all the necessary documents** as indicated in the checklist appearing on the last page of the application form. Please note that any scholarship form submitted without any requested document and or signature appended ***shall not be processed***.
4. The application process begins on **Tuesday, 20<sup>th</sup> January 2026** and closes on **Friday, 6<sup>th</sup> February 2026 5.00 p.m.**
5. The completion and submission of application form is ***NOT*** a guarantee for scholarship.
6. Completed application forms with certified copies of mandatory requirements shown in the application form should be sent or hand delivered to the Ward Education Coordinator at the ward administrators' offices during working hours on or before **Friday, 6<sup>th</sup> February 2026 5.00 p.m.**
